

What did you like best about how the course was taught?

Comments
Lots of worked examples that demonstrate different cases under a specific subject matter
The proofs given were very thorough and clear
I appreciated Abhi's availability to answer questions both in-person during office hours and online via email. He was great at answering my questions and explaining them to me in a way I could understand.
The content presented was very clear and thorough.
The teaching of new material was clear and easy to understand. Difficult topics were broken down in ways that I could easily understand. The in-class example problems strongly supported by understanding of the important concepts, theorems, etc. The 1.5 hour time blocks per day were utilized in a very efficient way such that I learned a lot in a short amount of time. I imagine it would be very difficult to condense a course in Linear Algebra into just 6 weeks, but Abhi did it very well. Even though he is a grad student with presumably somewhat limited experience as an instructor, he taught this course at a level I would expect from a full tenured professor (and in some ways, better).


If you were teaching this course, what would you do differently?

Comments
I would offer more notes and/or study materials online, such as providing a loose plan of topics for each lecture or week, or providing digital copies of notes for future reference
Nothing
I would have short quizzes once a week to evaluate students' understanding. It would not only put more grades in the grade book, but allow both the student and instructor to see the student's progress throughout that week's instruction.
Offered office hours directly before or after class at least once a week.
My main feedback is that I wish there was more opportunities to learn/practice. Each homework was only 3–4 questions, so I didn't have a lot of practice with some of the other material, and often had to rely on finding practice problems online. It also would have been helpful to have some sort of supplemental material to the lecture (e.g., lecture notes pdf's). A general schedule on the syllabus of what would be covered for each day would have also been helpful so that I could review some main topics prior to class so that I didn't have to spend so much time copying everything down during class and could instead focus more on understanding the material as its being presented.





The lecture instructor's attitude toward the subject was enthusiastic.


