# **AFFILIATION AGREEMENT**

### BETWEEN

# THE PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA

### **AND**

UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD BRADFORD, PA

### **AFFILIATION AGREEMENT**

THIS AFFILIATION AGREEMENT is made between the PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY and UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD. THE PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY and UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD are desirous of cooperating in providing a joint undergraduate/professional program of education leading to the degree of Doctor of Optometry. It is contemplated that both institutions will coordinate their respective activities to achieve the above mentioned objective.

In consideration of this mutual objective, both institutions agree as follows:

- I. Acceptance of Students PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY agrees to provide places in the first professional year class for students who have successfully completed their undergraduate prerequisites at UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD and satisfied other admission requirements of the PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY. Admission Selection Guidelines attached.
- II. Joint PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY/UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD Admissions Committee Candidates for entrance into the first professional year of optometry shall be presented to PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY for admission by a Joint Admissions Committee established for that purpose.
  - A. Composition The Committee shall be composed of a total of five (5) members with two (2) members appointed by PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY, two (2) members appointed by UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD and one (1) practicing optometrist from the BRADFORD, PENNSYLVANIA area. The Chairperson of the Committee shall be elected by the Committee.
  - B. **Professional Community Representative** The practicing optometrist member shall be proposed by the PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY and confirmed by the UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD.
  - C. **Ex-Officio Members** The Director of Admissions of both institutions shall be exofficio members of the Committee.
  - D. **Notice of Meeting** PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY recommends that the meeting site of the Joint Admissions Committee alternate between each campus from year to year.
  - E. **Curriculum** The Affiliated Optometry Education Curriculum shall consist of a minimum of 90 undergraduate semester hours and four (4) years of optometric education.

- F. Consideration for Admission PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY shall enter candidates recommended by the Joint Admissions Committee. Applicants may be considered during their third or fourth year of attendance at UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD and may be admitted to PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY following the completion of 90 semester credits or more at UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD.
- G. **Degrees Awarded** Upon the successful completion of one (1) year of basic science education at PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY, UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD shall award a baccalaureate degree. It is agreed that upon the successful completion of the Affiliated Optometry Education Curriculum, PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY shall award the degree, Doctor of Optometry.
- H. Responsibilities of UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD shall recruit students to participate in the Affiliated Optometry Education Curriculum.
- I. **Duration of Agreement** This Agreement shall be effective immediately upon the signing of this documents and shall continue thereafter from year to year unless terminated by either Institution upon one (1) year's prior notice.

#### APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES

### FOR UNDERGRADUATE AFFILIATION PROGRAMS

The Affiliation Agreement between Pennsylvania College of Optometry and University of Pittsburgh at Bradford has been established to provide a joint undergraduate/professional program of education leading to the Doctor of Optometry degree. Below are the application, interviewing and selection procedures for this program:

### **NOTIFICATION**

- I. UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD will be responsible for notifying the Pennsylvania College of Optometry of the students that are participating in the joint optometry undergraduate/professional programs as they enroll.
  - A. Pennsylvania College of Optometry will communicate with these students as they proceed through their undergraduate program and encourage them to visit the College's campus for a tour and/or counseling.
- II. Application Procedure to Pennsylvania College of Optometry The College strongly encourages applicants to apply in the Fall prior to the year of admission. Applicants must:
  - A. Submit a properly completed application accompanied by a non-refundable \$50 application fee to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry, Office of Admissions.
  - B. Submit official transcripts of all previous college credits.
  - C. Arrange to take the Optometry Admissions Test (OAT) and have results forwarded to the Office of Admissions.
  - D. Have sent to the College three letters from faculty members teaching natural science subjects. These may be copies of letters on file at the University of Pittsburgh at Bradford that the student received as he/she progressed through the program.

Additional references from optometrists and other health

professionals may also be provided at the discretion of the applicant.

### III. INTERVIEW PROCEDURE

- A. Pennsylvania College of Optometry The candidate will be invited to be interviewed at Pennsylvania College of Optometry in accordance with interview procedures (see attached). Interviewers will submit written reports to be added to the candidate's folder.
- B. UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH AT BRADFORD will interview candidates on their campus by members of the Joint Admissions Committee and the Community Optometric Representative. These written reports should be forwarded to Pennsylvania College of Optometry to be added to the candidate's file.

The scheduling of the interviews will be at the discretion of the candidate and each Institution. The Interview reports should follow the same format at each institution. If there is any concern or problem with either interview, the candidate will be requested to come for a second interview by the Joint Admissions Committee when they meet.

IV. Pennsylvania College of Optometry/University of Pittsburgh at Bradford Joint Admissions Committee shall be called in accordane with the agreement. (Meeting sites will alternate between Institutions.) The candidate's application file will be reviewed and discussed at this meeting and a recommendation from the Committee will be forwarded to Pennsylvania College of Optometry's Director of Admissions.
