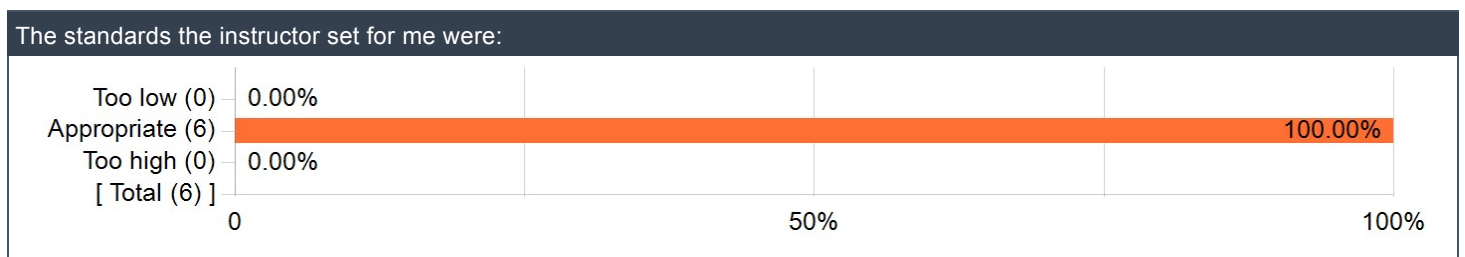

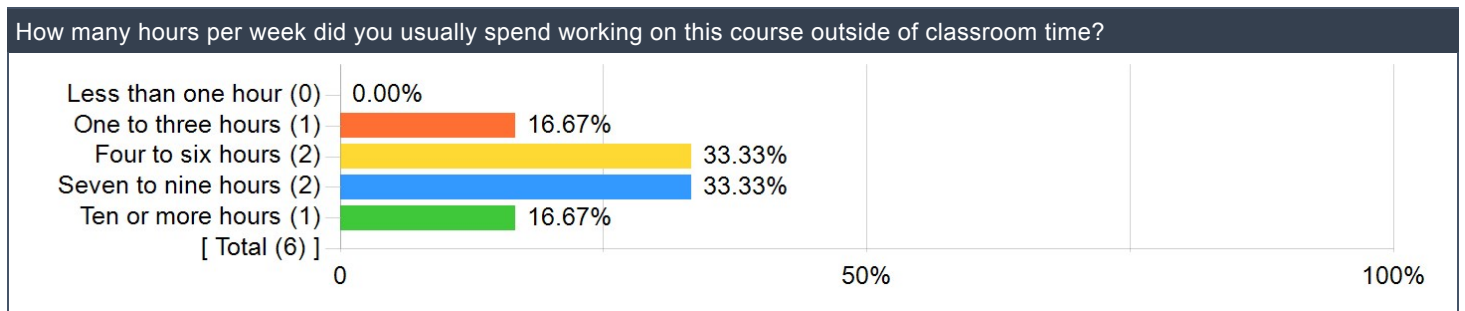

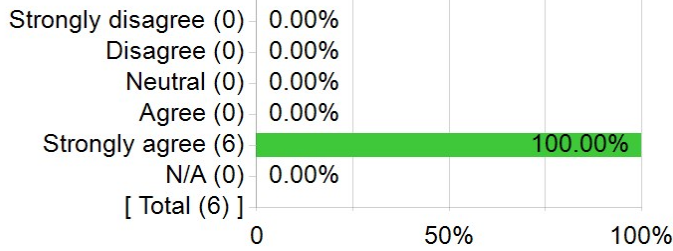


### How many hours per week did you usually spend working on this course outside of classroom time?

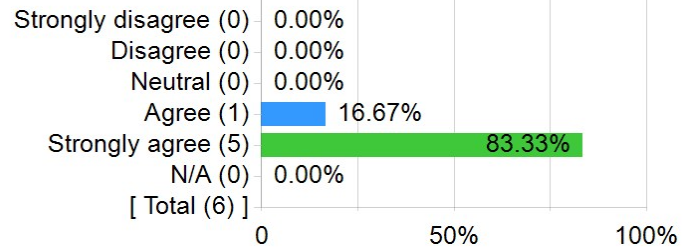
