Normal functions and the Archmedean Height

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Normal functions are objects which were introduced by Poincare and then used by Lefschetz to prove his famous theorem about dimension 2 cohomology classes on algebraic surfaces. I will explain some of the history of normal functions since then and some new results on the growth of normal functions which are joint work with Pearlstein.
