
Centrifuge Instructions

1) Place samples to be centrifuged in the plastic inserts for the appropriate size Falcon tube (15ml on the left, 50 ml on the right).




- 2) Turn on the centrifuge.
- 3) Press the release button to open the lid. The power must be on to open the lid.



4) Place the inserts into the centrifuge cups. MAKE SURE THAT THE CENTRIFUE IS EQUALLY WEIGHTED ON ALL SIDES. If the centrifuge is not balanced, it will shut itself down.



5) Set the centrifuge to the desired rotations per minute (RPM) and length of time to be centrifuged. For carbonate sample 1 minute at 4000 RPMs is generally adequate. **Do not adjust the rotor/radius**.



- 6) Make sure that both the startup and slowdown settings are set to fast (the rabbit icon).
- 7) Press the green arrow to start
- 8) If you need to stop the run before the time is finished, press the red stop sign button to abort.
- 9) Press the release button to release the lid.
