The new PCL season is rapidly approaching. Organizational flyers were sent out to team captains in early August. That mailing included last year's roster with the official August ratings for all of their returning players. Then, we will be having our organizational meeting to turn in new rosters on Thursday September 15 in the Concourse Dining Area of the William Pitt Union at the University of Pittsburgh.

For most teams, that means individual players should be getting in contact with their team captains sometime this August. And in particular, it is always helpful for captains to know both who is interested in playing again this fall and who may be playing for a different team.

On our own organizational front, Earl Clary, Jr. has decided that he won't be able to serve as an officer this year. Kevin J. Fitzgibbons, team captain for Gallant Knights, has indicated

that he is willing to serve. If anyone else is interested they should contact me as soon as possible, so that I can let all of the captains know. We will try to have the election as part of the process of turning in rosters, so as not to add any further activities to the already hectic first round.

Kevin has also volunteered to help me with processing and checking roster changes made during the league rounds. As you all probably know, I am fairly busy at the start of the round with pairing alternates, collecting USCF memberships, setting up my team, and sometimes even playing myself. So, when team captains add or move players I often am unable to make sure that such changes are legal. Often I have had to have captains indicate such changes on the back of their result sheet and only later have found out that they were trying to do something not allowed - resulting in forfeits.

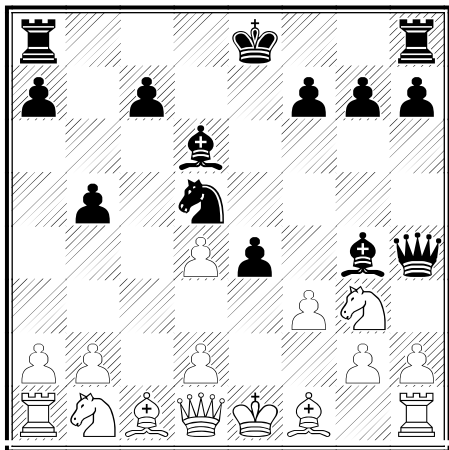

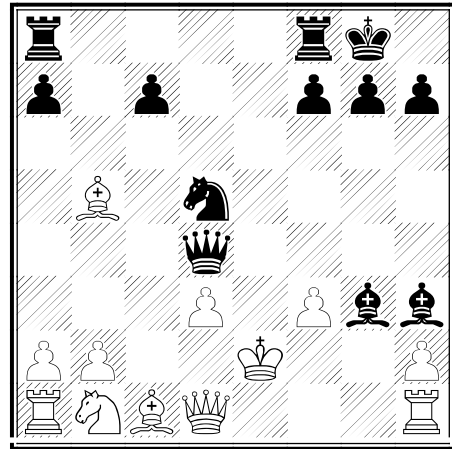

12.Kf2? *[12.Bxb5 Kd8 13.O-O is the main line. That is an extremely complicated position, but Black is considered to have adequate compensation for his invested material. After allowing Black to castle, White is probably lost. Not only is Black's King safer than in the main line, but even more importantly now both of his rooks may easily participate in the attack.]* O-O 13.Bxb5 exf3 14.gxf3 Bh3 15.d3? *[15.Qa4 looks like the best try. Losing the doubled d4 pawn isn't significant materially, but when the Black Queen gets to d4, the White King's death is imminent. One possibility is 15...Nb4 which renews the threat to d4, but at least the Knight is now somewhat removed from White's King and after 16.d3 Qxd4 17.Be3 his king has some protection. Another forcing line is 15...Nb6 16.Qb3 Qxd4*
