1. National History of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.:

In the spring of 1996, Founding Monarch Melissa Jo Murchison-Blake wanted to be part of a family on the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill campus that openly embraced all women and crossed cultural boundaries. As a bi-racial woman, she did not want to choose between historically Caucasian or African-American sororities. Founding Monarch Murchison-Blake felt that if she did choose one, she would be denying half of her heritage.

Still wanting to be part of a strong sisterhood, Founding Monarch Murchison-Blake recruited six other diverse women to join hands in her quest to found Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority. At first, the Founding Monarchs were discouraged from fulfilling their vision. They were advised to consider joining an existing organization, and told that a new organization, based on the principal of multiculturalism, would not survive at UNC-CH. However, the Founding Monarchs believed there was a need for such a sisterhood. (*National History continued, next page*)

After much work and dedication, the Founding Monarchs built the foundation for Theta Nu Xi. Finally, UNC-CH officially recognized Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority as the Alpha Chapter on April 11, 1997.

2. Nu Chapter History:

In the spring of 2001, Founding Sister Natasha Khan became interested in Greek Life at the University of Pittsburgh. However, she found that this wonderful opportunity created for the female student body did not actually reflect the diversity of the female student population. She desired a sisterhood that embodied the ideals of diversity, and after finding support in Founding Sister Erika Strauss, they went on a search to find a sorority that aligned with their own personal values of culture, service, and scholarship. After much searching they found exactly what they had been looking for: *Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.*

In Fall 2001, they met Founding Sister Teresa Bernaciak, who also desired to found an organization with high ideals, one with a true and diverse sisterhood and a strong commitment to service. In late Fall, the Founding Sisters submitted a proposal for the colonization of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc., on the University of Pittsburgh campus.

On April 14, 2002 Founding Sisters Khan, Strauss, and Bernaciak crossed into this sisterhood as

"ONE-der Women", and by August 2002 the Nu Colony was revealed to the University of Pittsburgh, becoming the first Multicultural Greek Letter organization on campus.

3. Mission Statement, Motto, and Tenets of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.:

Mission Statement: "To promote leadership, multiculturalism, and self-improvement, through academic excellence, involvement in and service to the campus and community, as well as being living examples of sisterhood across different races, cultures, religions, backgrounds, and lifestyles."

Motto: "Sisters of Diversity Together as ONE"

Tenets: Scholarship, Service, Sisterhood, Multiculturalism, and Leadership.

4. Scholarship Information:

With this scholarship, Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc., would like to recognize and reward a member of the University of Pittsburgh community who embodies the qualities of Leadership, Scholarship, Service, and Multiculturalism through their involvement with the campus and community and their dedication to success at the collegiate level.

This award will be given every Spring Semester to one full-time undergraduate female who is currently enrolled at the University of Pittsburgh. *The applicant may not be a member of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.* The award will be given in the amount of \$200 to be used at any University of Pittsburgh bookstore. The applicant must fulfill the following requirements to be eligible for the Scholarship:

- Applicant must have minimum GPA of 2.5
- Applicant must include an unofficial transcript
- Applicant must include a resume
- Applicant must complete attached Application Materials (see page 3)
- Applicant must **not** be a member of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.

- **Scholarship Essay-** – In essay format not exceeding one page (typed, double or single spaced at 12 pt font with 1 inch margins), we would like to know: *What are your future academic plans and how close are you to achieving them?* Please attach your essay on Scholarship to the rest of your application materials.
